Online RN to BS Completion Program*

Fall Semester Only Must hold RN License

APPLICATION DEADLINE

Rolling admissions

All applicants to the nursing program must meet the safety and technical standards. Applicants for the Distance Education RN to BS Completion Program must hold an unencumbered RN license and current RN registration from the state in which they reside.

Applicants must be graduates of an accredited associate degree nursing program. The applicant must also show competence in all transfer Science and Nursing courses (the typical student admitted has grades of B or better in all courses). The RN to BS Completion Program consists of 60 college credits beyond the associate degree (27 credits in the major and 32-36 credits of liberal arts and sciences).

Transfer credits will be evaluated after acceptance. Students who enter the SUNY system after Fall 2000 must complete all General Education requirements as outlined in the College Catalog, which is available online. A maximum of 90 credits are transferable (including the degree nursing courses).

As of May 2018, California, Massachusetts, and Puerto Rico, are not currently members of the National Council for State Authorization Reciprocity Agreements (NC-SARA). Due to states' regulatory requirements on distance education, residents of these states and U.S. territories are ineligible to enroll in the online RN to BS Completion Program.

- Applicants are responsible for making sure they are eligible for licensure and employment at the time of application.
- Advanced Biology highly recommended (AP Biology, Anatomy & Physiology and/or College Biology)
- Completion of minimum prerequisite courses does not guarantee admission. Applicants are ranked according to grades and TEAS exam score.

All prerequisite courses required for the advanced standing program MUST be completed by the end of the Summer term, prior to the October 15 deadline.

* Applicants must attain a grade of "B" or better to be considered. Only one attempt is allowed within 5 years (withdrawals are counted as an attempt).

Meeting the minimum requirements does not guarantee admission and all applicants will be ranked on the following:

Advanced Standing Rubric

- TEAS Total Exam Score: 30%
- Cumulative GPA: 30%
- Prerequisite GPA: 40%

This is not an accelerated nursing program and will take a minimum of three years to complete, regardless of prior coursework.

- TEAS (Test of Essential Academic Skills). Visit atitesting.com for more information.
- Students can take exam in person or remotely.
- TEAS scores are valid for one calendar year (from deadline to deadline)
- Applicants must provide an official transcript from ATI by the deadline.
- Study materials are available at atitesting.com. Students may take the exam two times in a calendar year and must wait a minimum of 30 days in between tests.
