


## What is Title IX?:

Title IX includes any form of sex discrimination, sexual harassment, sexual violence, sexual assault, dating violence, domestic violence, stalking and quid pro quo harassment.

Title IX also covers gender identify discrimination.

## What is my responsibility as an officer if someone discloses a possible Title IX incident?

There are 4 possible avenues of reporting. You can encourage the member to do any of the following. As an officer you can report it directly to the Title IX Coordinator, Kathleen Flynn or Fraternity/Sorority Life advisor William Finnegan



## <u>Contact the</u> <u>Title IX Coordinator if:</u>

- You or the student are unsure what or how to report.
- You are upset about something you think happened.
- You have a friend who is not ready to report but you need to talk about it.

## **Important Notes:**

- As an Executive Board Member: once you do 1 of 4 options, your responsibility is complete.
- Once it is reported the victim is safe from retaliation.
- If someone who is under 21 has used Alcohol and/or Other Drugs, reports an incident they will not get in trouble
- The same process applies whether the incident happens on or off-campus
